







# Plurals: 's' 'es'

*Plural noun indicates that there is more than one person, animal, place or thing. A singular noun only indicates that there is one.*

## Singular noun






# Plurals

If the noun is not irregular and does not end in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch' or 'sh', we add 's' at the end to make it plural.

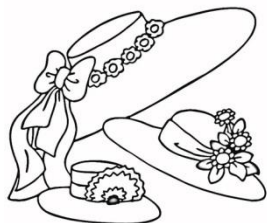
