

The pyramids were built by Ancient Egyptians. The Egyptians built them to store all sorts of items and treasures with their Pharaoh. A Pharaoh is a person who is the supreme ruler of Egypt, like a king.

There are over 100 Egyptian pyramids. The largest is over 480 feet tall! They were built more than 4,500 years ago. Every pyramid has four slides that slope upward and meet at a point.






It is hard to tell what is inside a pyramid, as to this day we still don't know what is inside. There are no maps and clear pathways.

It is still unknown how they were built. It is believed that thousands of slaves were used to build the pyramids by making and using large blocks. Pyramids are usually built when a new Pharaoh comes. It can take over 20,000 workers and 23 years to build one pyramid.
