We convert the verb to the **-ing** form.

I am	sleeping
You are	staying
He is	eating
She is	living
It is	talking
We are	playing
They are	working

Future & Continuous Tense Review

Simple Future tense has two different forms. By using '**will**' and '**be going to**' can refer to a specific time in the future.

- I **will** help you.
- He **will** come to school.
- Are you **going to** be at home?
- You are **going to** class today.

We use the word '**will**' to suggest that the subject may do something voluntarily. We also use '**will**' to respond to requests for help. The negative form is '**will not**'.

- I **will** give you the money.
- I **will** not go home.
- **Will** you help me?

We use '**be going to**' to express a plan or if a person intends to do something.

- I am **going to** sleep.
- She is **not going to** school today.
- I am **going to** be a teacher.
