Comparative: '-er'

Rule 1: short + er = shorter

Rule 2: hot + er = hotter

Rule 3: weak + er = weaker

Rule 4: large + er = larger

★ Rule 5: heavy + er = heavier

Special Case: Slow + er = Slower

Low + er = Lower

Add -er for  
short adjectives of  
1 or 2 syllables!

few - fewer

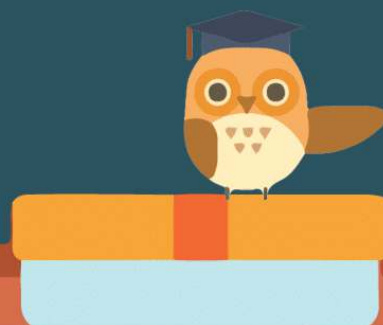
bad - worse

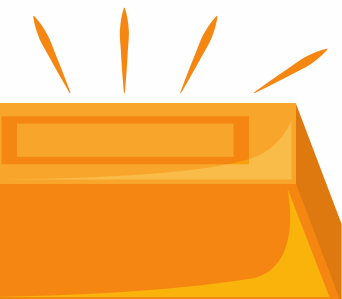

## Superlatives

Rule 1: short + est = shortest

Rule 2: hot + est = hottest

Rule 3: weak + est = weakest

Rule 4: large + est = largest

Rule 5: heavy + est = heaviest

Special Case: Slow + er = Slowest

Low + er = Lowest

Add **-est** for  
short adjectives of  
1 or 2 syllables!

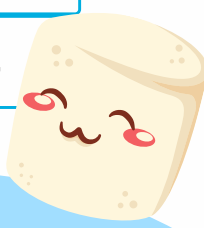

little - less - least

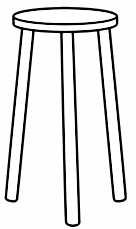
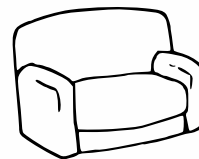
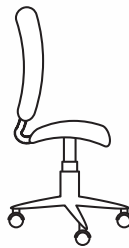
