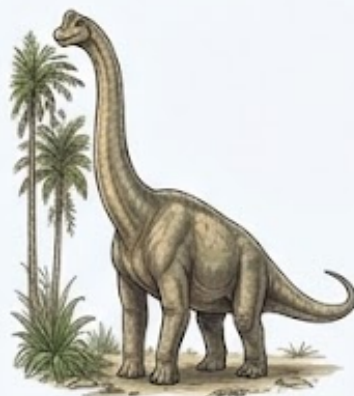
The full name of this dinosaur is **Brachiosaurus**, which means "**Arm Lizard**".

The full name of this dinosaur is **Stegosaurus**, which means "**Roofed Lizard**".

Stegosaurus was a massive plant-eater, known as a **herbivore**. Its most famous feature was the two rows of big, diamond-shaped **plates** along its back. These plates helped with temperature control and protection. At the end of its powerful tail, Stegosaurus had sharp, defensive spikes, often called "**thagomizers**". Stegosaurus lived about **150 million years ago** in western North America.



Although it was large, its tiny head had small teeth perfect for munching on low-growing plants.

Unlike other flyers, Pterodactyl had a **short tail** and a body perfect for perching.

Pterodactyl lived about **150 million years ago** in Europe.

Although it was not as large as some later pterosaurs, its ability to glide and flap made it a perfect hunter.
